Collecting Information that may identify our visitors/clients

Certain visitors to CompuBrainTM's websites choose to communicate with CompuBrainTM where it will require CompuBrainTM to gather information that will identify it's clients/visitors. The amount and type of information that CompuBrainTM gathers depends on the nature of the communication and information shared or requested. Website Visitors
